A NEW LABOUR COUNCIL WILL:

PUT THE INTERESTS OF LOCAL PEOPLE FIRST



- Double Council Tax on second homes
- Introduce a rental property licensing scheme to regulate AirBnB's and tackle absentee landlords

PROVIDE HOUSING THAT PEOPLE CAN GENUINELY AFFORD



- Double the number of council homes built each year by building on land we own
- Cap council rents at 30% of the lowest incomes in our area
- Make affordable homes available only to local people
- Use powers to turn empty properties into homes for local people to rent

SUPPORT LOCAL BUSINESSES




- Reinstate the tourism development team to support events in our towns

- Make reporting problems easier with a new mobile app to redeploy street cleaners and a 0800 number for missed bin collections
- Open community hubs in each town
- Together with headteachers create a traffic plan for each school. Deploying enforcement officers to make drivers switch off engines when waiting outside schools.

LISTEN TO YOUR CONCERNS



- Close the Guildhall and hold council meetings around the district
- Relaunch local forums with police and health officials
- Establish a Youth Council to build youth services

GIVE POWER BACK TO LOCAL PEOPLE



- Involve residents in how councillors spend their money and support the funding of community events
- Hold a Governance Review within two years to decide on town councils
